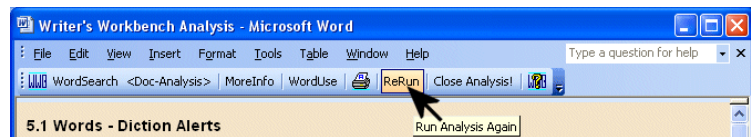

What's new in Writer's Workbench Version 8.17?

Dear Writer's Workbench Enthusiast:

Just a quick note to alert you to enhancements and additions in this release of Writer's Workbench.


-  More versatile display resolutions – now including support for high-resolution monitors and display settings to compensate for non-standard toolbar selections
-  Word's window sizes (composition and analysis) now can be reset with keyboard macros - <Alt-Ctrl-Shift-W> for a little larger windows (usually best in Windows '98) or <Alt-Ctrl-Shift-S> for a little smaller windows (usually best in Windows 2000 or Windows XP)
-  Better error checking and better messages to help debug problems with schools' security programs
-  Better handling of abbreviations and strange punctuation as Writer's Workbench determines sentences
-  Timeout now adjustable for slower computer systems (Writer's Workbench Options Menu)
-  Writer's Workbench Manuals, Faculty Guides, Orientations, Ordering Information, PowerPoint Show, and Brochures now installed with the software – click “**Start, (All) Programs, Writer's Workbench, Documentation**” – feel free to view or print these documents as needed
-  A new button on the WWB Analysis Toolbar allows the writer, after making changes to the composition, a quick rerun of his or her analysis
