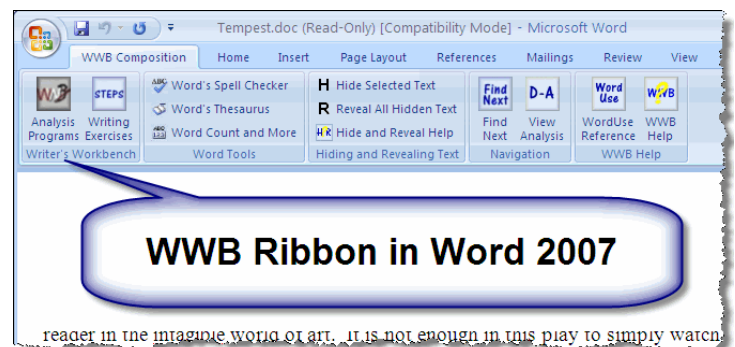
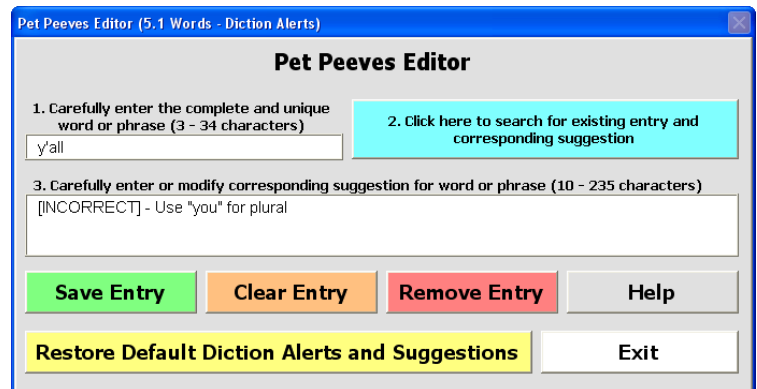

Just a quick note to alert you to the exciting new WWB Version 8.2 enhancements included with this release.


-  Easier to read analysis menu
-  More statistics in the Assessment module – now analyzes 22 statistics that can easily be used to track writing improvement through Excel or a database program – Create your own writing standards!
-  A new "Pet Peeves" module, where teachers or users can add their own problematic words and phrases to the Diction analysis and modify suggestions if the program finds those words or phrases
-  No need to uninstall previous release - upgrade overrides appropriate files from previous installations
-  New, more descriptive message boxes help guide users through navigation of the programs
-  Compatibility enhancements for Word '97, Word 2000, Word XP, Word 2003, and Word 2007
-  More "Word 2007 friendly" – now works with Word 2007's ribbons
-  New WWB Help and documentation reflect WWB in previous Word releases and in Word 2007's new interface
